Welcome to the 2019 edition of the annual Novated Leasing Guide produced by Fleet Auto News. If you're reading this for the first time I hope you find it helpful in explaining the benefits of novated leasing.

The guide is laid out in a simple way showing the purchase price, monthly rental and the annual savings available from salary packaging for over 200 cars. You can compare different vehicle types and model variants at a glance.

Categories are used to separate the different type of cars to help narrow down your choices. If you're looking for your dream car, Luxury and Sports will be the sections for you. If it's to upgrade the family car, you should head straight to SUV Medium or SUV Large depending on your family size.

There's a broad range of vehicles with an indicative monthly lease rental on each one. This is because most of us desire cars with a purchase price beyond our reach. Though when you convert the cost of ownership to a fixed monthly amount you may be able to put the one you want in your driveway sooner than you planned.

We've also tried to simplify the information on the savings available with a novated lease. The data on each vehicle is not comprehensive. It's a sample of the information you'll see on a novated leasing quote to introduce you to the important terms.

At first it does seem complex because of the industry jargon like PAYG, GST and FBT. Though if you take the time to understand how it works it will make sense. And the savings are real compared to buying a car using other financing methods.

If you are considering a novated lease, now or in the future, this guide is for you.

It's also for the person within an organisation that gets asked all the car questions. It may be the Fleet Manager, or it could be Human Resources, Finance or Procurement.

Please share this guide with your colleagues, family and friends to help them better understand the benefits and vehicle affordability offered through a novated lease.

# SAVE MONEY BY USING YOUR PRE-TAX DOLLARS

It's simple really. You pick a car and then save some money by using pretax dollars. Not quite getting it? That's OK. It takes a while because it seems too good to be true.

If you're planning to buy a car (new or used) using finance, and work for an employer that offers salary packaging benefits, you should spend some time to find out about novated leasing.

It may sound complicated. And it will take you some time to understand if it's your first time. But isn't that the case with most things to do with money? Once you get your head around the finance part and tax savings, the extra benefits that make car ownership easy are more than worth it.

For example, the cost of fuel, rego and servicing are all included in the monthly rental. This means you won't get the high petrol price blues or preservice financial anxiety attack. Your budgeting is taken care of as part of the novated lease.

With a novated lease most people can save some money compared to financing a new car using their post-tax salary. And if you work in a government role like health, policing or education you can take advantage of the extra benefits on offer. There are also extra benefits for people that work in the Not for Profit sector.

Then at the end of the lease term (normally three years) you have several options. If you love the car you can own it. If your circumstances change you can sell it. Or if you just want to change your look, you can with a new novated lease.

# A NOVATED LEASE VS PAYING CASH FOR A CAR

Are you planning to buy a car? Do you already own a car? What does it cost to run?

The good news is you could end up with more dollars in your pocket with a novated lease compared to owning it yourself. It's true! Novated Leasing is a great way to save money by salary packaging a vehicle.

All you need to do to take advantage of this legal (and easy) way of reducing your tax bill is to work for a company that offers salary packaging as an employee benefit. So what's the difference between owning a vehicle and a novated lease? The first thing is the running costs are paid from your salary before the tax is taken out. This reduces your income which also reduces the tax you pay.

What do we mean by running costs? Well the obvious one is fuel. You also have servicing, finance costs and insurance. When they are included in the lease, the financier claims the GST input tax credit which is like you getting a 10 percent discount. And with a novated lease all the expenses are combined into one monthly rental which makes budgeting easier.

Sure, it'll take some time to get your head around the benefits. But do the research. Take the time and you'll thank us.

There's plenty of information online, including calculators that will detail the savings. Just Google novated leasing and start from there. Or talk to your HR people.



# WHAT HAPPENS AT THE END OF THE LEASE?

This is a good question to ask. Many first timers don't think about, or understand, what happens when their novated lease ends. You need to pay out the residual value and it can be a shock if you're not prepared.

The key feature of a novated lease that makes them so affordable is the amount you finance. You are not financing the full purchase price of the car. You are financing the difference between the purchase price and what the car is worth at the end of the lease which is referred to as the residual value.

Depending on the car you pick, the lease term and kilometres travelled, the used value of your car will be higher, or lower, than the residual value. To avoid nasty surprises at the end of the lease you should ask the leasing company to help you 'forecast' what your car will be worth at the end when the residual payment is due.

The process at the end of the lease is simple and you usually have three options:

- Sell the car and pay out the residual value
- 2 Pay out the residual value and keep the car
- 3 Trade-in the car for a new one and get another novated lease

Option one and three require you to maximise the sale price to reduce your

out-of-pocket expenses. This means selling the car to a retail buyer which can be a hassle.

Selling the car to a dealer or wholesaler is the easiest option though you are paying for the convenience. The price they offer will be approximately \$2,000 to \$5,000 less than the retail market value.

An alternative is to use one of the specialised fleet auction companies that have products to help you maximise the price of your used novated lease vehicle. They can guarantee you a minimum sale price and then offer your car to retail buyers to maximise the sale price. Ask your leasing company to find out more.

# **QUESTIONS** and answers

#### Why is it called a novated lease?

This is because of the special three way agreement between the employer, employee and leasing company. The document used to formalise this agreement is called a novation agreement.

A novation agreement is a common legal document used when assigning responsibilities (i.e. payment of your lease by your employer to the leasing company) to a third party.

### What's the difference between Recommended Retail Price (RRP) and on-road cost?

RRP retail is the manufacturer's listed price for the vehicle only. The on-road cost includes registration fees, purchase stamp duty and dealer delivery costs.

### Can I get a novated lease on a used or demonstrator vehicle?

Yes. Each leasing company has different restrictions on the age of used vehicles that can be financed so you need to check first. But if you're buying a young, low kilometre car there should be no issues. You could also lease the vehicle currently parked in your driveway.

There are plenty of other questions to be answered and that's where a specialist can help. Contact one of the advertisers in this guide, or your organisation's preferred provider.

### Where do the annual savings come from?

The savings come from a reduction in the initial purchase price through buying power and from not paying GST. There are also savings in fuel, maintenance and tyres (once again not paying the GST). And the last component of the savings comes by using pre-tax salary.

### Why is there a difference between onroad cost and the amount financed?

The on-road cost is what you would pay when buying the vehicle yourself. The amount financed is the total onroad vehicle cost with a novated lease. It's lower because there is no GST and some vehicle manufacturers recognise novated buyers as a fleet buyer. So they provide extra discounts that may not be available to a retail buyer. The leasing companies also negotiate lower dealer delivery charges and extra discounts.

### Do you have to drive high kilometres to benefit from a novated lease?

No. Even employees driving less than 7,000 kilometres per annum can benefit.

### What happens if I change employers?

Here are some of the options if you leave your current employer but you should also check with your current provider.

- Organise a new novated lease with your new employer through their preferred provider.
- 2 Continue to pay your lease payments and all running costs to the leasing company until the end of the lease.
- ③ Pay out the lease by selling or purchasing the vehicle.

### Estimated Annual Savings After Tax\*

This is the estimated financial benefit of a novated lease compared to owning and financing the car yourself from post-tax salary.
